1.	Evaluates the patient's condition prior to transfer.		
2.	Secures the wheelchair.		
3.	Provides the patient with short, simple commands.		
4.	Raises footrest to avoid injury.		
5.	Directs patient to sit on the edge of the wheelchair.		
6.	Instructs patient to assist by pushing down on the arms of the chair.		
7.	Assists patient to stand using proper body mechanics.		
8.	Pivots patient to place back of thighs against table.		
9.	Secure stepstool.		
10.	Assists patient to step onto stepstool with strongest leg first.		
10.	Assists patient onto table.		
11.	Practices Standard Precautions.		

	RADIOGRAPHIC TABLE TO WHEELCHAIR	Yes	No
1.	Moves tube housing and/or fluoroscopic units into a safe position.		
2.	Places wheelchair alongside of the table and secures.		
3.	Raises footrests and locks chair wheels.		
4.	Assists patient to sit on the edge of the table.		
5.	Secures step stool.		
6.	Assists patient to stand on the stepstool.		
7.	Assists patient onto the floor, strongest leg first.		
8.	Pivots patient to sit into the wheelchair.		
9.	Places feet onto footrests.		
10.	Covers patient if appropriate.		
11.	Practices Standard Precautions.
